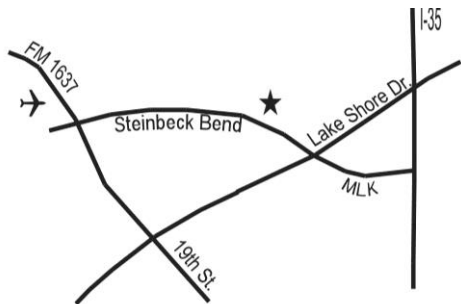

Cash advance items and cemetery expenses (third party expenses) are not included in the guarantee. Some funeral homes fail to disclose additional fees that may be necessary. These include cemetery expenses, obituaries, honorariums (clergy, musicians, soloists, altar servers), escorts, flowers, death certificates, catering, sales tax, etc. We will be more than happy to give you a quote so that you will have an estimate that is as accurate as possible since many of these fees vary.

PAYMENT POLICY

Methods of Payment prior to services being rendered:

1. Cash, Check, Money Order, Cashier's Check
2. Credit / Debit Cards: Visa, MasterCard, Discover (we do not accept American Express.)
3. Pre-paid Funeral / Cremation Contract from our funeral home or from other funeral homes
4. Life Insurance: must be verifiable, assignable, and past the contestability period of 24 months. We cannot accept insurance for cases where the Justice of the Peace or Medical Examiner has filed a "pending" delayed death certificate.

Please Note: If you pay with a check or cash, we will gladly discount our charge 2%. If you pay with insurance, we have an insurance processing surcharge fee of 6.25% on the amount assigned.

PRE-ARRANGED PLANS

We will honor other local and non-local funeral home prepaid funeral plans which are valid, currently in force and transferable. Lake Shore Funeral Home offers two types of prearrangement plans. You may prepay for the services in advance which freezes the cost on the items you selected. The cost will never change. We offer monthly payment installments for these pre-paid plans. You may also pre-arrange the services you desire and not pay anything in advance. In this case the cost may change in the future with inflation but your wishes will be kept on file at our facility.

Schedule of Fees & General Price List

This General Price List is available for your retention, if you so desire. These prices are effective **November 15, 2023**, but thereafter are subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

An * below indicates standard items that make up a "traditional service charge".

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF * \$2,595

Includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service 24 hours a day, 7 days a week; arrangement conference with family and responsible party; arrangement of service including preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits, recording vital statistics, preparation and placement of obituary notice, and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., clergy, cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others, as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, secretarial and administrative expenses.

This fee will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

First Hour of Consultation Fee is \$400 (in-person or via phone - at residence, funeral home, medical facility, etc.). A proportionate share of our Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff fee that is billed separately when client family terminates our services for another funeral service provider. All fees incurred including this fee for initial service / assistance are due at time of when servicing funeral home arrives for transfer of custody to the receiving funeral home.

NOTE: Only a licensed funeral director can physically take custody of the decedent from our facility - protecting the best interest of all parties. \$400 + Removal + Embalming / Refrigeration (per day), etc. are not included.

PREPARATION

EMBALMING / SCIENTIFIC PREPARATION BY A LICENSED EMBALMER * \$895

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. *Lake Shore reserves the right to require embalming if there will be public viewing of the body.*

Refrigeration of Unembalmed Remains (per day after Removal / Cremation Permits issued / Plus any Delays)..\$95 per day
(In accordance with Texas Law, unembalmed human remains sheltered by the funeral home shall be placed in refrigeration after 24 hours from time of death until final disposition.) It is the policy of Lake Shore Funeral Home that all remains that are not embalmed and / or not casketed will not be placed in public areas for public viewing. Viewing of remains that are not embalmed and / or not casketed is limited to immediate family members and will be done in a private area (behind glass for public health reasons) at the funeral home for a specified time frame set forth by the funeral director.

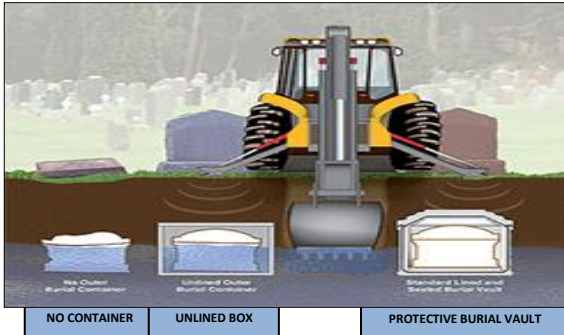
